**Summer Training Report
for the Students of the Faculty of Nutrition Science
Academic Year 2024-2025**

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About 50 students (male and female) from the first academic level of the faculty scientific departments were trained at the Regional Center for Food and Feed – Agricultural Research Center for a duration of five days.

The center welcomed the students on the first day of training in the presence of Prof. Dr. Naeem Rabeh, Dean of the Faculty, and Prof. Dr. Alaa Osama, the training supervisor. The students were received by Prof. Dr. Mohamed El-Sherbiny, Director of the Regional Center for Food and Feed.

Dr. Nasser Shaaban, Deputy Director of the Regional Center for Food and Feed, gave an introductory presentation covering the center's activities and services. This was followed by a series of specialized scientific lectures on theoretical foundations and the importance of microbiological analyses, protein, chemistry, moisture and ash. These lectures were delivered by the heads of the specialized laboratories at the Regional Center for Food and Feed.

After that the practical training for the students continued (the students were divided into five groups) and were distributed across the center's laboratories (Microbiology, Chemistry, Protein, Fiber and Fat, Moisture and Ash) throughout the remaining days of the training. They were introduced to the practical equipment used in each lab, the basic scientific method for estimation, the official estimation procedures, and the steps followed to carry out various analyses.

This training comes within the framework of the Regional Center for Food and Feed's keenness to support university students in the fields of nutrition and food analysis.
